Suggestions from the members:

1. **Prof. Ch. Pulla Rao, Professor & Head Chemistry, IIT-TPTY, suggested to introduce B.Sc.(Data Science) course, if it is feasible.**

Data Science is one of the emerging technologies these days. The demand for that specialization is quite encouraging as evident from B.Tech.(CSE-Data Science) course at MVGR. As for as introduction of B.Sc.(Data Science) course is concerned, it is to state that this course is already there in M.R. College(A), another college under the same society.

2. **Dr. G. Kalyani, Ex-Principal, MR College, VZM, suggested to introduce B.Tech.(AI&DS), as the combination Artificial Intelligence(AI) and Data Science(DS) is more popular and prevalent in reputed institutions including IIITs.**

The combination of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Data Science (DS) is undoubtedly more popular and prevalent in reputed institutions including IIITs. MVGR already has a similar kind of combination at one of its UG courses: B.Tech.(AI&ML)

3. **Prof. K. Babulu, Prof. of ECE, JNTUGV, suggested to introduce a few M.Tech. Courses in emerging technologies including VLSI.**

MVGR had six M.Tech. programs till the academic year 2022-23. Five of them were closed because of the low demand if not nil.



4. **Prof. N. Ramanaiah, Prof. of Mech., AU, proposed to link funded / research projects to M.Tech. admissions. Project Assistants / Associates with B.Tech. qualification may be encouraged to take admission in to M.Tech. They complete M.Tech. course by the time they complete the project or little early. He further advised to engage the M.Tech. students in Teaching Assistantships as it will be a win-win situation to both the student and the institution.**

Running an M.Tech. program with a lesser admission strength is leading to underuse of resources available. For example, as per the norms in vogue, Institute is to maintain faculty at the rate of 1:12 ratio (in case of M.Tech.) for the full intake capacity even if the actual admissions are lesser than intake or nil. Otherwise, Institute gets deficiency as per the AICTE norms.

As far as encouraging Project Assistants / Associates to take admission in to M.Tech. course is concerned, it gives mutual benefit, as suggested, to both student and the college. However, there must be a project and an M.Tech. program either in the same stream or allied streams of Engineering.

As far as engaging M.Tech. students in Teaching Assistantships are concerned, this has been the practice of the Institution since long. Early Faculty Induction Program (EFIP) was launched in MVGR in the year 2012. A meritorious M.Tech. student, after completion of 1st year, is offered Teaching Assistantship with financial assistance. It worked well for years

5. **Prof. G. Venkataratnam, Institute Chair Professor., IIT-Madras, suggested to introduce (web enabled /online) M.Tech. programs for working professionals.**

In view of the above suggestions, it is recommended to explore the possibilities of introducing new courses by conducting a carefully designed survey to study critical parameters such as market demand for such courses, availability of expert faculty etc...
